Balmain & District Football Club Holiday Camps Terms & Conditions



- 1. By enrolling your child in a Balmain & District Football Club (BDFC) Holiday Camp (Holiday Camp you accept the following terms and conditions in their entirety and agree to be bound by the included disclaimer and exclusion on liability.
- 2. Holiday Camps are subject to cancellation, alteration and re-arrangement in the event of unsuitable weather conditions, insufficient numbers or other factors which may arise that are beyond the control of BDFC, its employees, officials and volunteers.
- 3. Where BDFC cancels a Holiday Camp session prior to sign-in, a full refund for that session will be available. If a participant is withdrawn or does not attend due to illness, injury or any other reason a credit to a future Holiday Camp may be issued. Such credit will be valid for 12 months and may be subject to an Administration fee.
- 4. BDFC reserves the right to refuse or terminate enrolment if the rules of the camp are not abided by. Specifically, as a community club BDFC operates a zero-tolerance policy to abusive or aggressive behaviour, physical or verbal. Any child deemed to be engaging in abusive or aggressive behaviour towards another participant, any BDFC employee, official or volunteer or any other person will be removed from participation at the absolute discretion of BDFC or any of its employees, officials or volunteers.
- 5. There is a risk of serious injury from sports activities. Such risks arise from (but are not limited to) impacts from sporting equipment, poor, wet or slippery surfaces, physical exertion, intentional or accidental contact or collisions with other participants, acts or omissions by BDFC, its employees, officials or volunteers. BDFC, to the extent permitted by law, does not accept any liability for personal injury, property damage or loss sustained by any participant as a result of his or her participation in a Holiday Camp due to any cause whatsoever.
- 6. BDFC retains the right to use for publicity and advertising purposes photographs of participants taken at the camp.
- 7. You authorise BDFC employees, officials and volunteers to obtain such medical assistance as they see fit and you agree to meet the expenses attached thereto.
- 8. You agree that BDFC has the right to retain and store the registration information submitted on a confidential database. This information will be removed at your request.
- 9. You hereby release, indemnify and hold harmless BDFC, its employees, officials and volunteers with respect to any and all injury, disability, death or loss or damage to person or property, regarding the child and/or arising from the child's activities, however arising including but not limited to any negligent act or omission, to the fullest extent of the law.
