Dear Paul,

Thank you very much for your letter. I can confirm my absolute support for Balmain & District Football Club's requests.

I have been working closely with Jamie Parker MP for many years on this issue and was so pleased to see he was able to secure \$50 million for the Rozelle Parklands, up from the original proposal for only \$15 million.

As an elected Councillor on the Inner West Council, as well as having two children who play for BDFC, I know there is a great opportunity with this new parkland. I held a large public meeting recently at Easton Park with residents to discuss the issues you have raised in your letter.

I have a six-point policy for the Rozelle Parklands that incorporates the three requests from the BDFC, it includes:

- Ensuring priority all year-round access for BDFC to the rectangular field
- · Supporting the all-weather field
- Provision of adequate and suitable parking
- Ensuring filtration of the three exhaust stacks to protect our children from emissions
- Requiring safe pedestrian crossing from Easton Park into the Rozelle Parklands, and
- Delivering adequate funding for Council to provide for the ongoing care and management of the Rozelle Parklands

I am pleased to say our plan for the Rozelle Parklands has been met with very strong support within the sporting and wider community.

I am advised that Transport for NSW is undertaking a Traffic Study with the collaboration of the Inner West Council. That will help provide the detailed work required to facilitate parking.
